Race area and map:	Kirkemilen and Skagen City (ISSprOM 2019). 1:4.000 for Classes till W/M45 and for Open 1, 2, 5 and 6. 1:3.000 for Classes W/M50 and older and for Open 3 and 4. Equidistance 2,5 m. Drawn in 2019 and revised in 2023. Maps printed on tear and water-resistant paper. Mapper: Erik Flarup, Skive AMOK.
Terrain:	Dunes and city area. Varied street and path system. In the open dune areas occurs easy new tracks, which not are shown on the map. The controls stand in some areas very close, so check the control numbers.
Event Center:	Event Center on grass field. Marking from intersection at Road 40, Flagbakkevej 21, 9990 Skagen. GPS: 57.720222, 10.537194. Follow marking for 1.300 meter. Event Center is open from 15:00 hrs.
Parking:	On grass field at <u>Gammel Landevej 43, 9990 Skagen</u> . GPS: 57.721472, 10.552722 Follow instructions from parking attendants.
Distances:	Competition Center, Skagen School to parking: Ca. 3,5 k. Parking to Event Center: Ca. 200 m. Event Center to start: Ca. 100 m.
Markings:	Parking to Event Center: Follow yellow/blue marking. Event Center to start: No marking because start is at the Event Center.
Rules, responsibility, and dress code:	Race area is not closed, why normal traffic must be expected. Race surface is asphalt and gravel in the city and mostly sand in the dune areas. Show respect to the other road users, and attentiveness when you run around houses and similar. Participation is at own risk and the traffic law must be followed. Long pant is recommended and shoes with iron or steel spikes are not allowed.

Drawn in 2019 and revised in 2023. Maps printed on tear and water-resistant paper. Mapper: Gediminas Trimakas, Litauen and Erik Flarup, Skive AMOK.
Terrain:	Kirkemilen is a typical dune plantation. There are flat areas, but the main part of the plantation is untouched dune areas created by nature. Slightly to medium hilly dunes. The vegetation varies from general god runability to difficult permeable pine scrub. Generally good path and roads in the plantation, but in the open dune area paths can by indistinct.
Event Center:	Event Center on grass field. Marking from intersection at Road 40, Flagbakkevej 21, 9990 Skagen. GPS: 57.720222, 10.537194. Event Center is open from 15:00.
Parking:	On grass field at <u>Gammel Landevej 43, 9990 Skagen</u> . GPS: 57.721472, 10.552722 Follow instructions from parking attendants.
Distances:	Competition Center, Skagen School to parking: About 3,5 k. Parking to Event Center: About 200 m. Event Center to start: About 100 m.
Markings:	Parking to Event Center: Follow yellow/blue marking. Event Center to start: No marking because start is at the Event Center.

Maps printed on tear and water-resistant paper. Mapper: Gediminas Trimakas, Litauen and Kjeld Arildsen OK-Vendelboerne.
Terrain:	Tversted is a typically dune plantation. There are a few flat areas, but the majority are untouched natural forest and dune areas. The terrain varies from slightly to medium hilly. The vegetation varies from general god runability to difficult permeable pine scrub. In places, the use of large forestry machines has resulted in the expansion and modification of existing tracks.
Event Center:	Event Center and parking on a grass field. Event Center is open from 09.00 hrs.
Parking:	Small vehicles: Parking on grass field. Marking from Skagenvej (route 597), Skagenvej / Europavej 1, 9881 Bindslev. GPS: 57.588111, 10.266556. Follow marking 3 k. to parking. Follow instructions from parking attendants.

Drawn in 2022 and revised/enlarged in 2023. Maps printed on tear and water-resistant paper. Mapper: Jeppe Ruud, OK Pan og Jess Rasmussen, Viborg OK
Terrain:	Older market town with shops, backyards, schools, institutions, residential areas, parking fields and parks.
Event Center:	North end of <u>Christiansgave Park</u> in Hjørring City. Marking from roundabout at <u>Åstrupvej 2, 9800 Hjørring</u> . Ca. 200 - 300 m. via paths in a park to the Event Center. Event Center is open from 09.00 hrs.
Parking:	There is no parking at the Event Center. The participants must use available parking fields in Hjørring and walk or bicycle to the Event Center. See annex over possible parking fields in annex to the instruction.
Distances:	Hjørring to Event Center: About 50 k. Event Center to start: About 300 meters.

Rules, responsibility, and dress code:	Race area is not closed, why normal traffic must be expected. Race surface is primarily asphalt. Show respect to the other road users, and attentiveness when you run around house corners and similar. Participation is at own risk and the traffic law must be followed. Shoes with iron or steel spikes are not allowed.
The International Specification for Sprint Orienteering Maps:	The International Specification for Sprint Orienteering Maps (ISSprOM) is expected well known by all runners. • "Half Roof" (Light gray) = allowed to pass. • "impassable vegetation" (Dark green) = not allowed to pass.
	• "impassable wall/fence" (thick black line) = not allowed to pass. It's not allowed to 'punch' a control over an impassable vegetation or wall/fence. It's not allowed to run through a hole in a hedge if the hole isn't marked on the map. It shall be noticed that a low hedge, marked as impassable, not must be passed.
	Areas/passages, which according to the International Specification for Sprint Maps are forbidden, shall be respected.
Start:	 Put and run for all Classes: Stage 1: 10.00 - about 11.30 hrs. Stage 2: Is settled as soon as possible after 1. Stage. Expected start about 12.00 - 13.30 hrs. 1 minute start interval.

	Runners purchasing a start on the day, must wait at least 30 minutes before showing up at the start.

Competition Office:	Each day there will be a Competition Office at the Event Center. From Wednesday July 12 from 10.00 hrs there is a Competition Office at Skagen School, Skagavej 139, 9990 Skagen.
Rules of order:	Tobacco smoking and the use of fire at the race areas are prohibited.
First aid:	There is first aid at the Competition Office and there is a defibrillator.
Open courses:	On all stages there will be - to a limited extent - extra courses for sale (same as for ordinary classes). The courses are sold from the Competition Office at the Event Center as long maps are available. When maps for a specific course are exhausted, please refer to other relevant courses. Runners purchasing a start on the day, must wait at least 30 minutes before showing up at the start.
	 Opening hours: Wednesday, July 12 (Prologue, Kirkemilen/Skagen City) 15.30 - 17.00 hrs. Thursday, July 13 (Skawdysten, Kirkemilen) 09.30 - 11.00 hrs. Friday, July 14 (Skawdysten, Tversted) 09.30 - 11.00 hrs. Saturday, July 15 (Sprint, Hjørring Centrum) 09.30 - 12.00 hrs. Price per day: W/M -20: 105 DKK. W/M 21-: 130 DKK. In addition, rental of EMIT device of DKK 25 per day.
Controls:	Payment methods: MobilePay and Danish kroner. Stand with orange-white screen and EMIT device on top. Control number is indicated in black writing on white sign on both sides of the control.
Control system:	 EMIT shall be used. If your EMIT ecard is more than 5 years old and you are in doubt whether it works, you can have it stress tested at the Competition Office. Rental of an EMIT ecard, see EMIT ecard and EMIT ecard rental. If you finish missing a punch, you will appear in the results list with status DSQ. Check for yourself on your printed result strip whether you have the right Controls in relation to the Control numbers on the control description on your map. It is not enough that you have the right number of Controls, it must also be the right Controls in the right order. Maybe you punched a wrong control? Think it through yourself before approaching the Competition Office. Only the Competition Office handle questions about missing punches.
Make sure you're on the start list:	Put and run for all Classes. It is therefore important that you have complete control of: 1. That you are on the start list, 2. That your EMIT ecard matches what is listed on the start list, 3. And not least, which Class you should run.

In case of errors or corrections, please contact the Competition Office before you go to start.
Backup labels are provided at start. Backup label is inserted on the back of the EMIT ecard. In case of doubt, the backup label is used to check whether you have been to the correct controls. It is important that you press the EMIT ecard to the bottom at the Controls.
 It is encouraged to pick up the rental EMIT ecard as early as possible. It will be possible to pick up rental EMIT ecards from Wednesday 12 July between 10.00 and 14.00 in the Competition Office at Skagen School, Skagavej 139, 9990 Skagen. On race days, the rental EMIT ecard are handed out from the Competition Office at the Event Center, where there is an envelope with rental EMIT ecards for each club. In the envelope is a list of rental EMIT ecards numbers and names of runners who must use respective ecards. It is very important to take the right ecard. It is okay to pick up your own rental EMIT ecard and put the club envelope back. Check that the number of your EMIT ecard matches what is listed at the start list. The same EMIT ecard is used every day and is handed in after the last race. An EMIT ecard is personal and identifies the runner when they reach the finish. You are disqualified if you run with the wrong ecard, and an ecard cannot be used by multiple runners. Lost (not handed in) ecards are replaced with DKK 600.
There is no transport of coveralls from the start to the Event Center.
Put and run for all Classes each day. See participant lists at the start, as well as on the Skawdysten website www.skawdysten.dk from no later than Monday the 10 th of July at 20.00 hrs. There is a minimum of one minute starting interval.
IOF control descriptions are printed on the map and there are separate control descriptions at start. These can be used if you have a holder for the purpose.
 At the entrance to the starting area, your EMIT ecard is read by the starting staff, and a backup label is provided to your EMIT ecard. In the starting area before the starting boxes there are separate control descriptions (Holder required). The control descriptions are also printed on the map. In the starting area, starting boxes and locks with Classes have been established. Enter the lock that displays your Class designation. At the end of the lock, you get your map. Easy and Beginner courses get their map about two minutes before the start, and they are allowed to receive starting assistance, and shadowing is allowed. Check that it is your Class shown on the map. Do not read the course. The starting staff will wave you forward, and you must advance to an EMIT start device.

	The EMIT ecard must be reset at the first beep. This is done by loading it into the EMIT start device five seconds before starting. When the long beep sounds, the EMIT ecard is lifted, and time has started.
Easy and Beginner courses (shadowing and starting assistance):	It is the club's own responsibility to guide runners on Easy and Beginner courses. Shadowing is allowed on Easy and Beginner courses. No assistance from the starting staff can be expected.
Finish:	After you have passed the finish line (and punched the finish control # 100), the finish staff reads the EMIT ecard and a prints of intermediate time are handed out. The map can be kept. It is not allowed to show the map to runners who have not started. Rental EMIT ecard are handed over at the finish. If you have rented for several days, the ecard is kept and handed over on the last race day.
Results:	Printed Results lists will be regularly posted on the scoreboard, and results will be available online as soon as possible after the last runner has reached the finish line on the individual stages. If you have been disqualified (DSQ) , see above under control system.
	O-track are offered on all courses.
Prizes:	In youth classes up to and including W/M16 years, there will (depending on the number of participants) be prizes for the 3 best placed on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. Saturday for the 3 best combined times for both stages. The prizes are awarded when it is assessed that all participants in these classes have reached the finish line.
Raffle prizes:	Raffle prizes are selected from all participants every day. Winners can be found on the scoreboard. Prizes that have not been collected on race day will not be post-issued.
Children courses:	Children courses free of charge (No sign-up) Thursday, July 13 and Friday, July 14. • Start between 10.00 - 13.30 hrs. • Prize for all who complete.
Childcare:	Not provided.
Toilet, shower and changing facilities:	There are toilets at the Event Center each day. Bathing and changing facilities are not available.
Judge:	To be reached at the Event Center (via the Competition Office).
Late entries:	No late entries. Please refer to the open courses.
