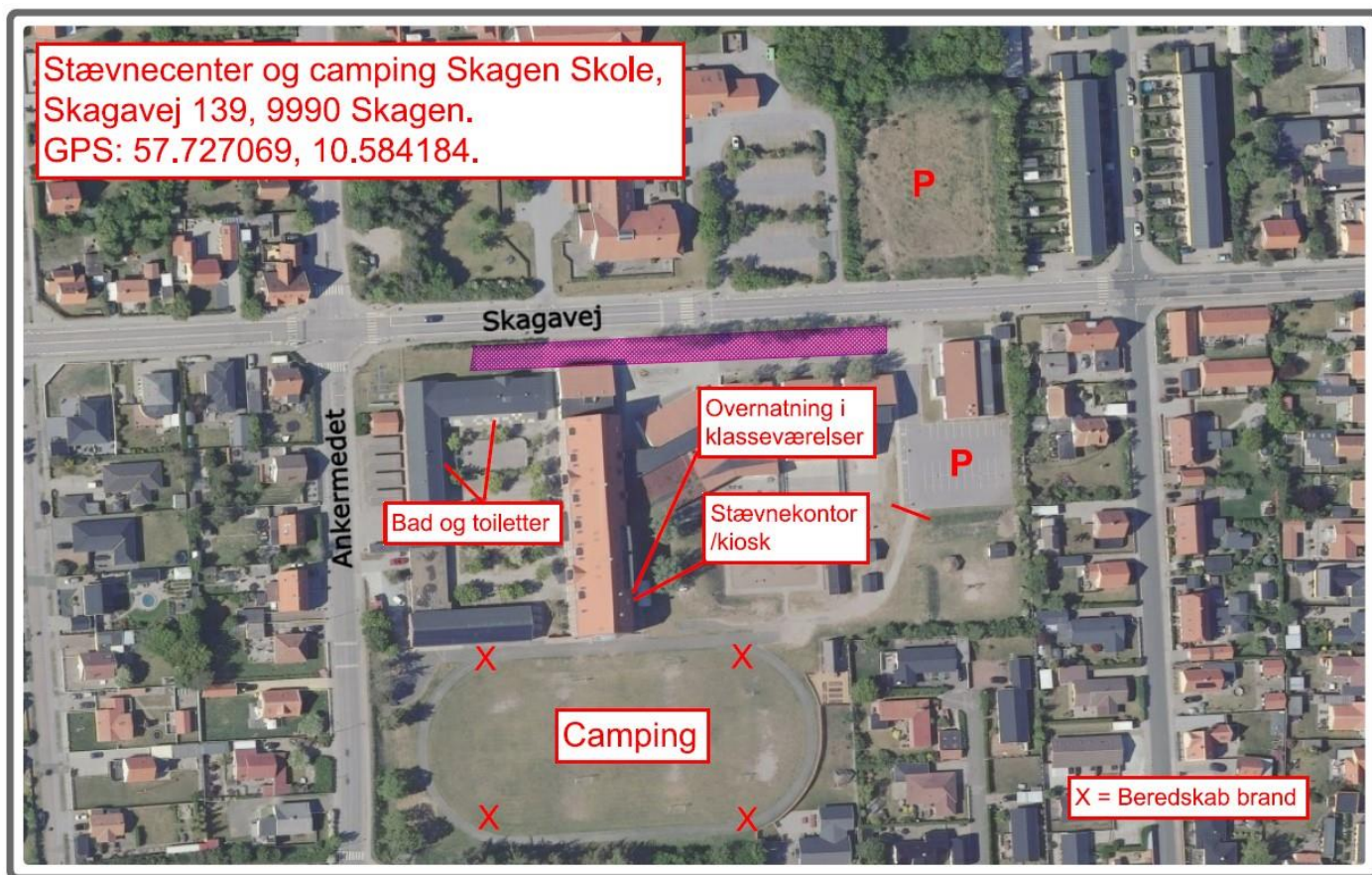


The campsite is located at Skagen School, Skagavej 139, 9990 Skagen.

Assignment of space and room takes place from the event office at Skagen School.

Accommodation:

- Skagen School, Skagavej 139, 9990 Skagen. Camping is available here.
- It will be possible to stay overnight from Tuesday 11 July at 12:00 to Saturday July 15 at 12:00, at the prepared campsite and in classrooms at the school.
- Please note that there are a limited number of places at the campsite. Bookings are on a first-come, first-served basis. When the space is full, Skawdysten reserves the right to refuse further bookings.
- There is limited capacity on power, but there are power supply points.
- Participants who have booked accommodation, please contact the event office at Skagen School during opening hours and are assigned a campsite or classroom, at the same time there will be a check of the number of overnight stays and pays.
- For safety and compliance with fire authority requirements, names for overnight guests in classrooms and campsites must be provided on arrival.

- See also notices about escape routes, etc. in case of fire (available in information).
- Under no circumstances are cars allowed to park on the campsite.

Registration and payment for camping and accommodation:

If you wish to be post-booked for accommodation at the campsite, an email must be sent to skawdyst@gmail.com

The email must contain information about arrival time, type of accommodation (tent, caravan, classroom) and number of people. Payment must be made on arrival (Danish kroner).

Price for camping:

- Tent, DKK 80,- (€ 11,-) per. night.
- Camp-let, DKK 90,- (€ 12,-) per. night.
- Caravan, DKK 100,- (€ 14,-) per. night.
- To the above prices DKK 50,- (€ 7, -) per person per night is added.
- Current. DKK 40, - (€ 5,5-) per. night.
- It is also possible to book accommodation stay on hard ground in a classroom for
- DKK 50,- (€ 7,-) per. person per night.

Kiosk:

Changing rooms/baths:

- Indicative opening hours:
 - Tuesday from 12:00 PM to Saturday at 12:00 PM.

Cooling packs:

- Can be exchanged at the conference office DKK 10 each.

Guard:

- There is a guard at the school (event office) throughout the event (Tuesday from 12:00 to Saturday at 12:00).

Breakfast:

- Not provided. Please go to local bread outlets and bakers. Distances 400-800 m. Information at the office.

Dinner:

- Not provided, but the city is famous for its many fine eateries.

Reminders:

- Access to the school premises, including bathing and changing rooms, is not allowed in running shoes (O-shoes).
- Participants are not allowed to prepare food on school premises.
- No smoking or alcohol may be consumed in classrooms.
- The Skagen School's premises are willingly provided by the Municipality of Skagen on reasonable terms. We would like to have the same opportunity later and therefore urge participants to be considerate and leave everything in the same condition as when received.
- The classrooms and campsite must be abandoned and emptied of debris no later than Saturday, July 15 at 12:00.
